Study Highlights

- Only one study previously examined the relationship between FOC and pregnancy outcomes, but did not measure FOC using a validated questionnaire.
- There appears to be no association between severe FOC (W-DEQ ≥ 85) and birthweight, birthweight centile and gestational age.
- Findings of the present study could be used when developing educational interventions to reduce and alleviate FOC.
