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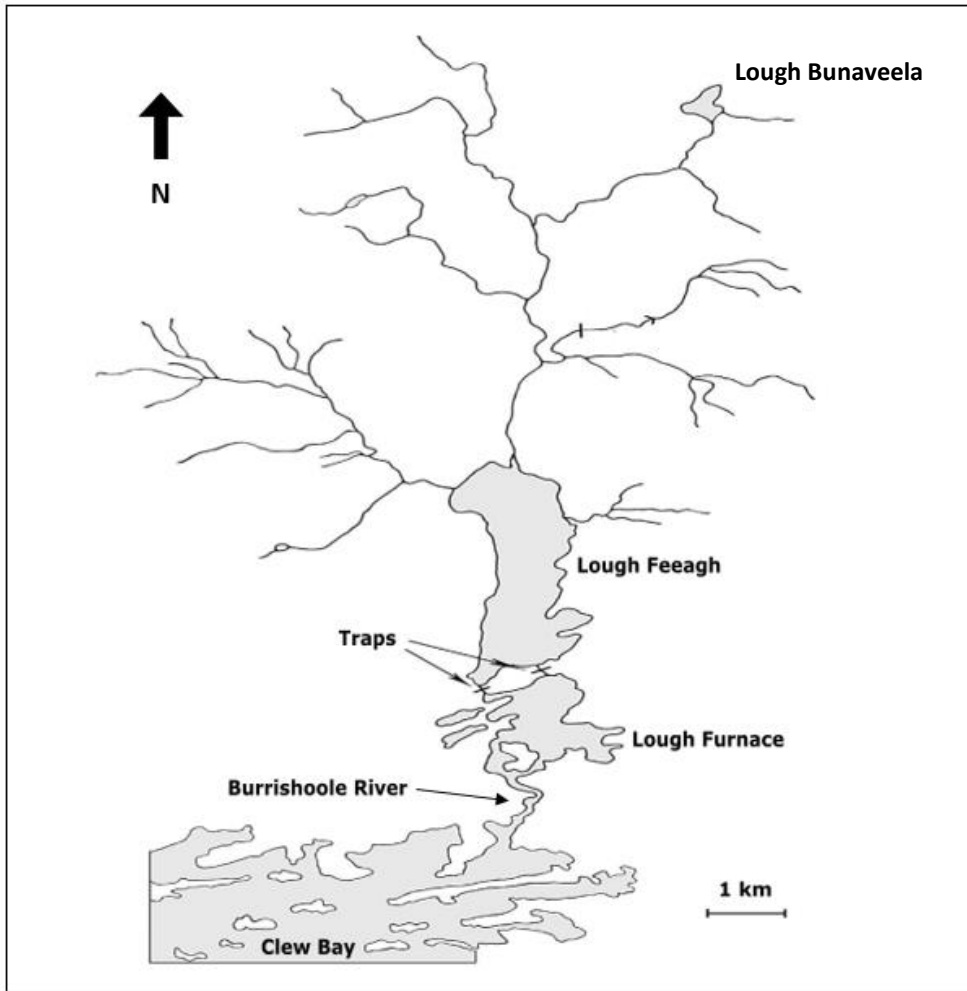


Figure S1: Map of the Burrishoole catchment, County Mayo, Ireland. Adapted from McGinnity et al., 2003.
