Semistructured Interview Guideline

1. How did the doctor initially inform you about the patient's cancer diagnosis?
2. How did you decide whether to disclose the true diagnosis to the patient?
3. What were the most influential factors in your decision-making process? (e.g., family opinions/ cultural beliefs/patient's personality)
4. What specific approach did you ultimately use to inform the patient?
5. How did the patient react after learning the diagnosis, and how did this influence your subsequent disclosure methods?
6. What roles did other family members play in the decision-making process?
7. What was the greatest challenge you encountered throughout this process?
8. Did your approach to disclosure change as treatment/cancer journey progressed?
9. Looking back, would you make different choices now?
