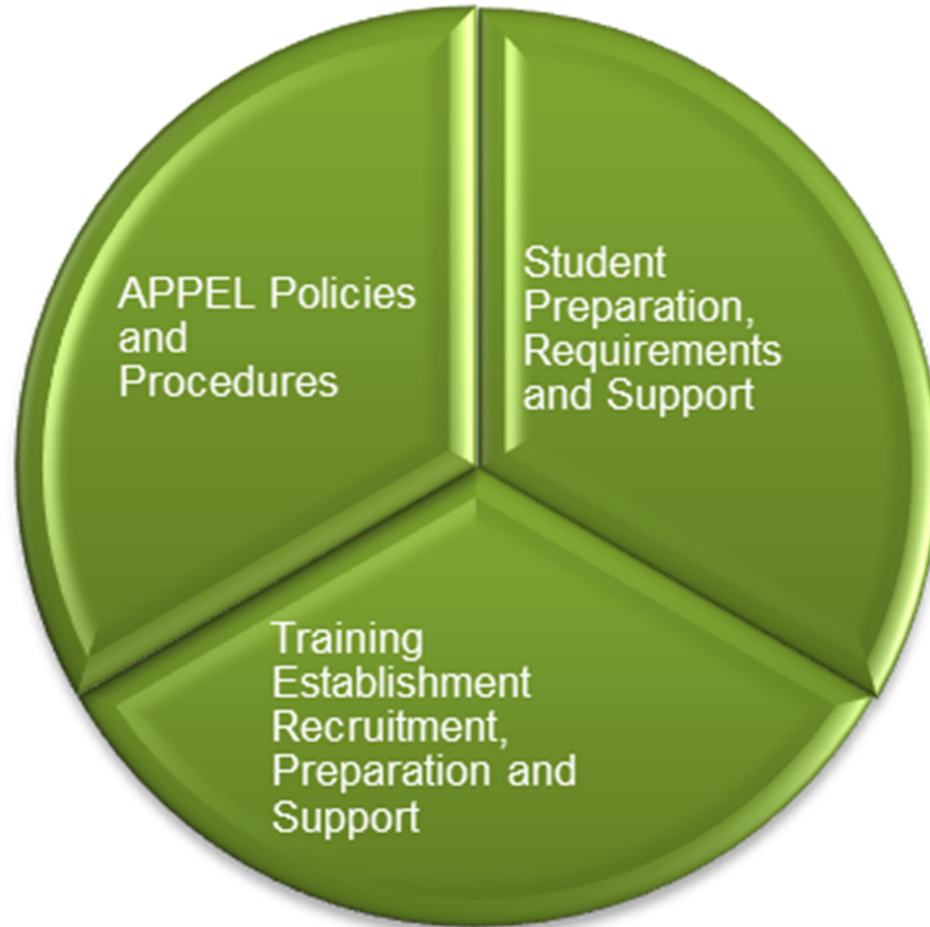

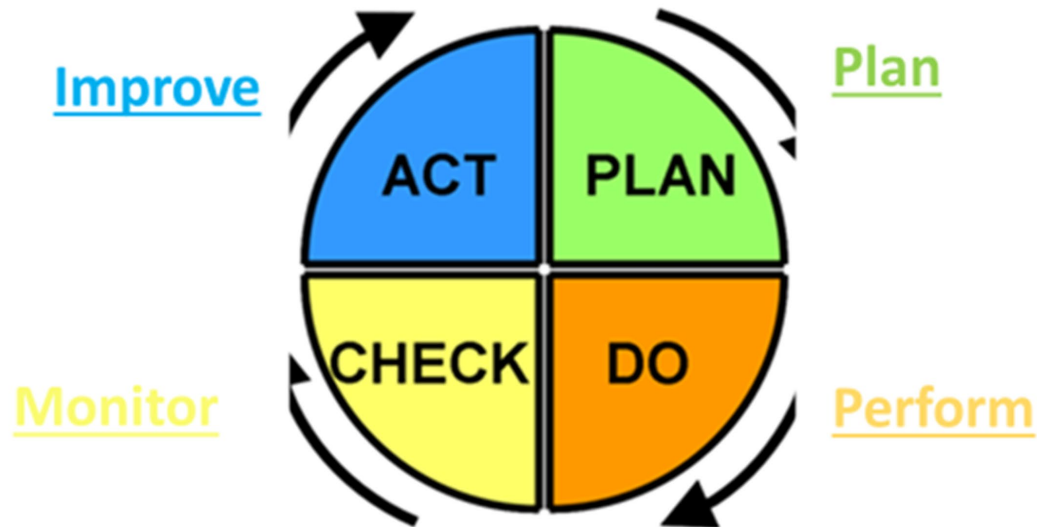

Deming Cycle



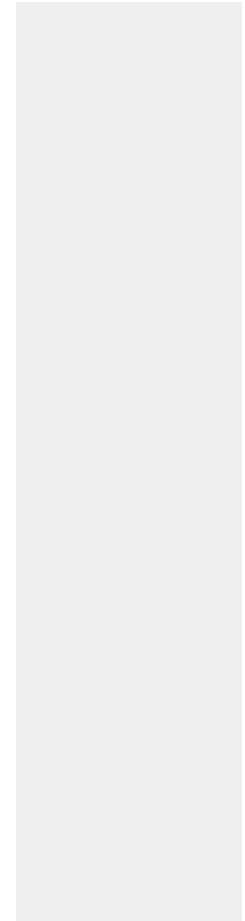
