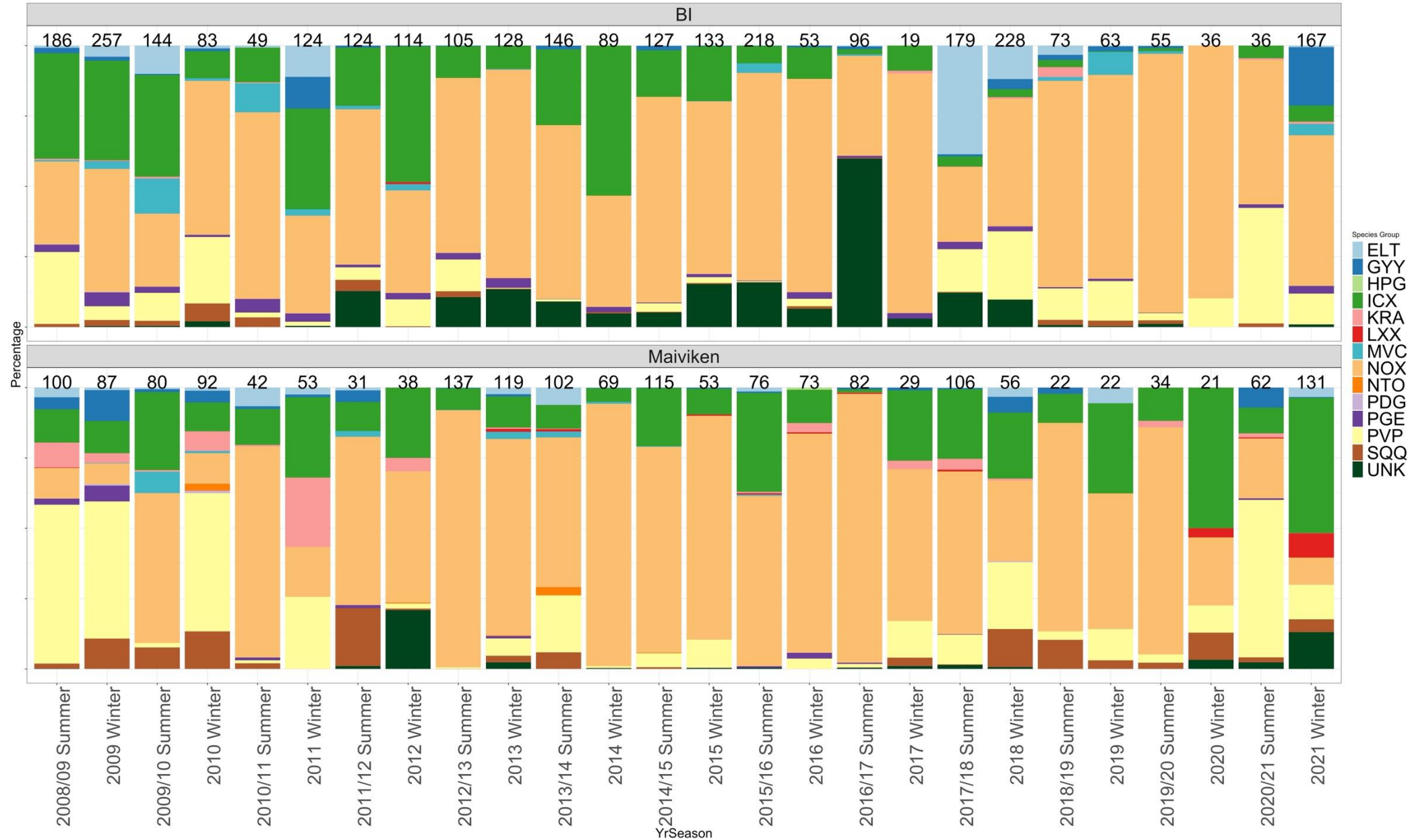


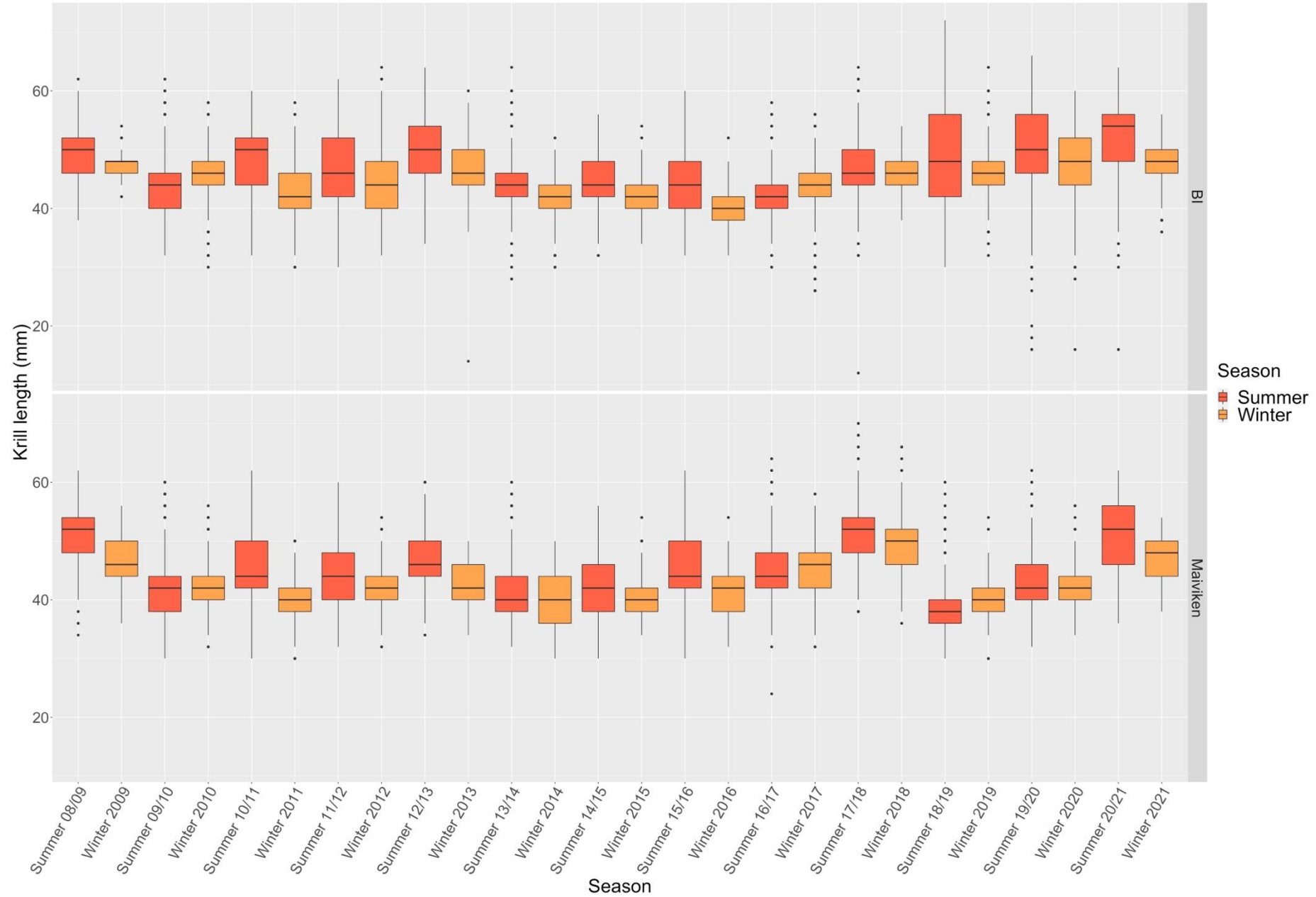

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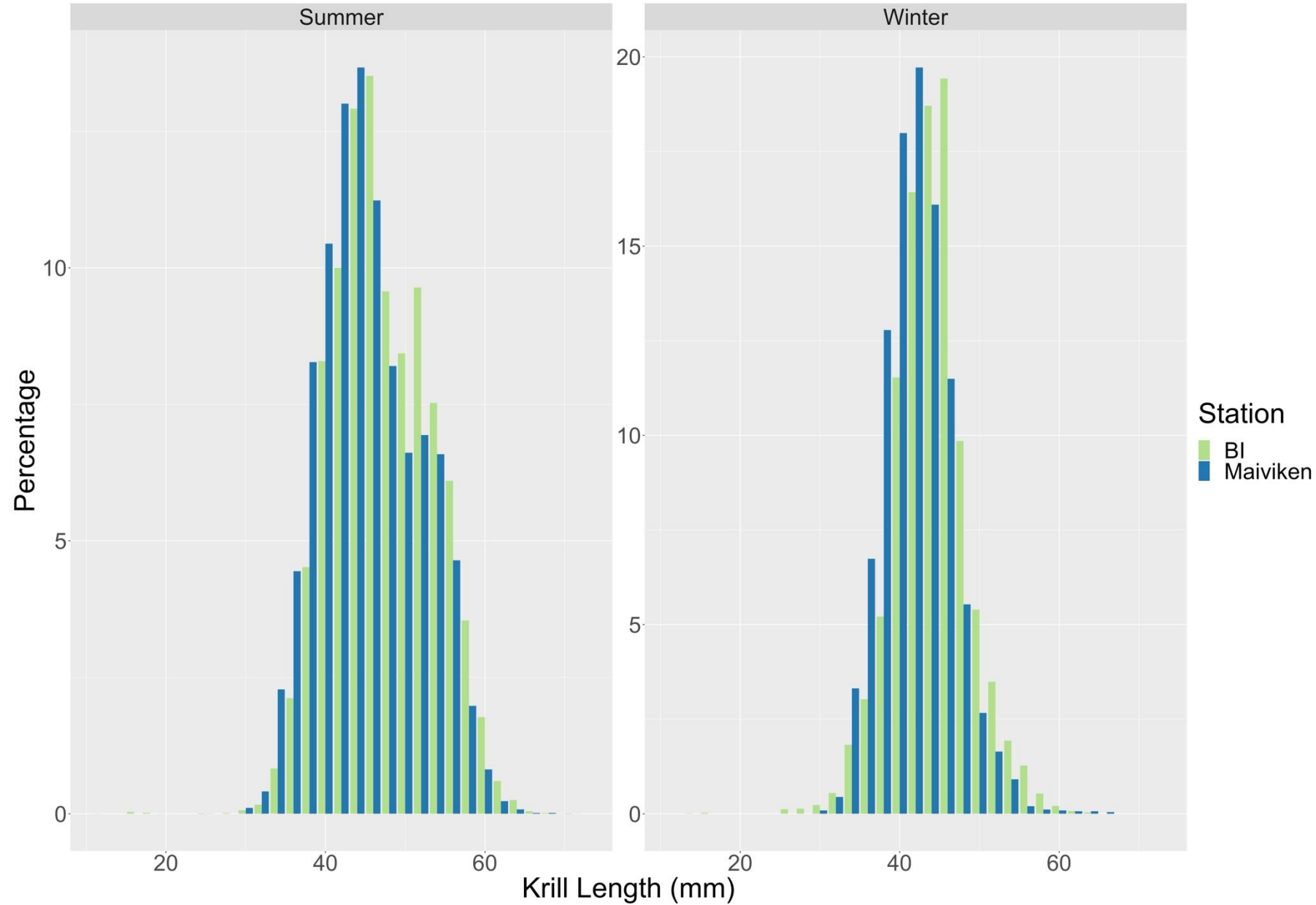

The proportion of different fish groups in the diet of fur seals; *Electrona* species (ELT), *Gymnoscopelus* species (GYG), *Harpagifer georgianus* (HPG) Channichthyidae spp. (ICX), *Krefftichthys anderssoni* (KRA) Myctophidae spp. (LXX), *Muraenolepis* spp. (MVC) Notothenioidae spp. (NOX) *Notolepis coatsi* (NTO), *Paradiplospinus gracilis* (PDG), *Parachaenichthys georgianus* (PGE), *Protomyctophum* spp. (PVP), Teuthoidea spp. (SQQ), unknown species (UNK). 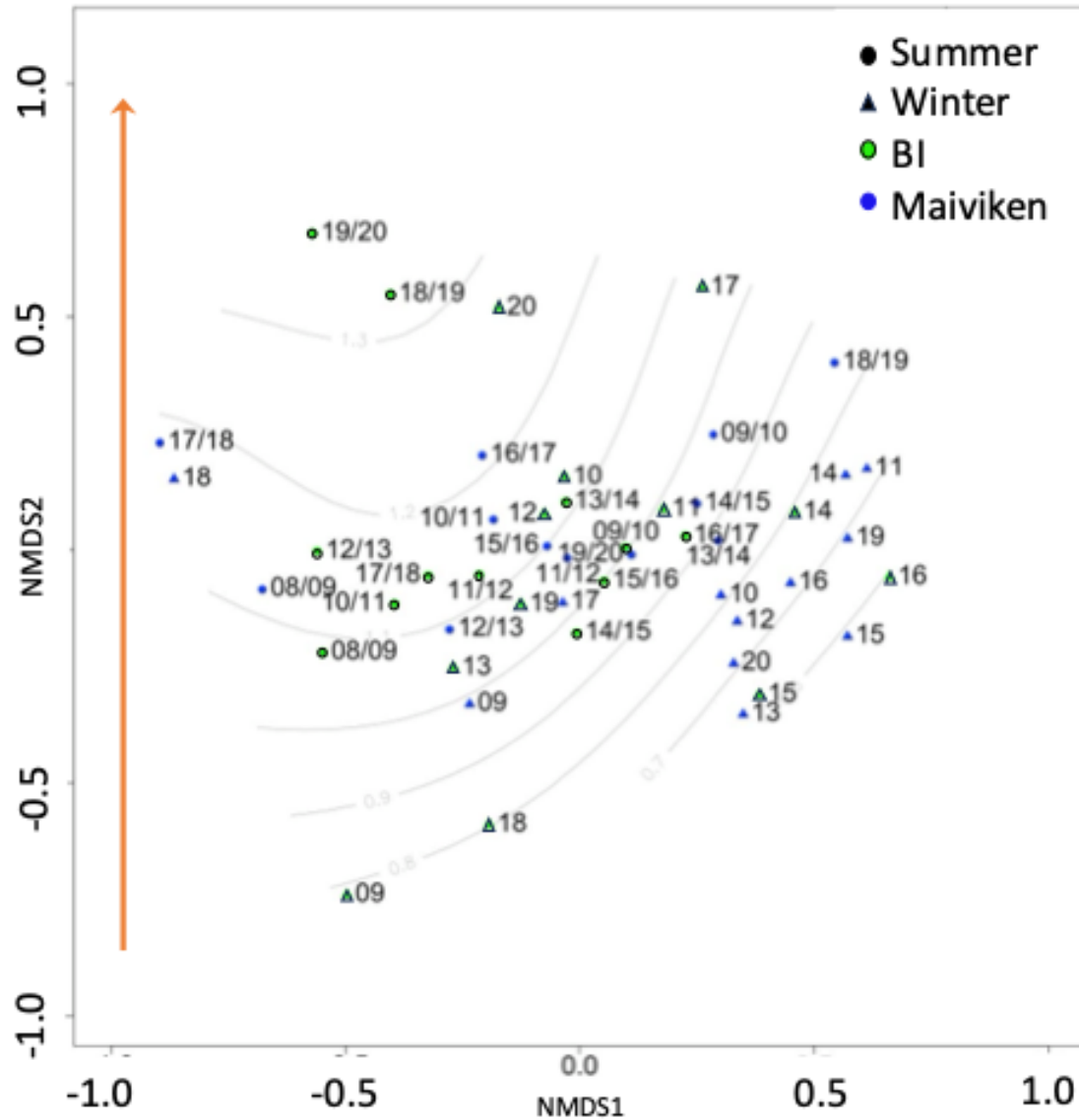

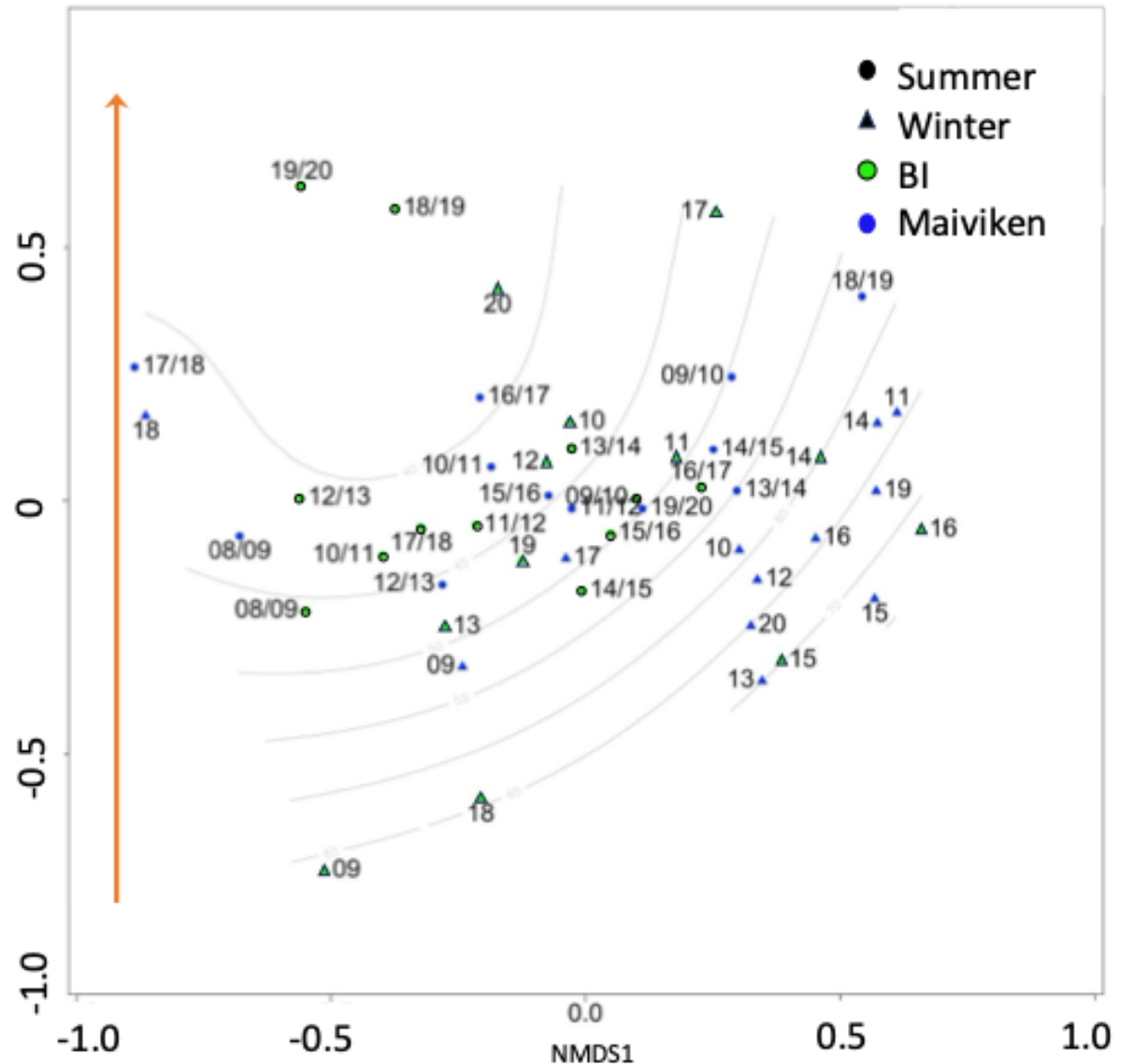

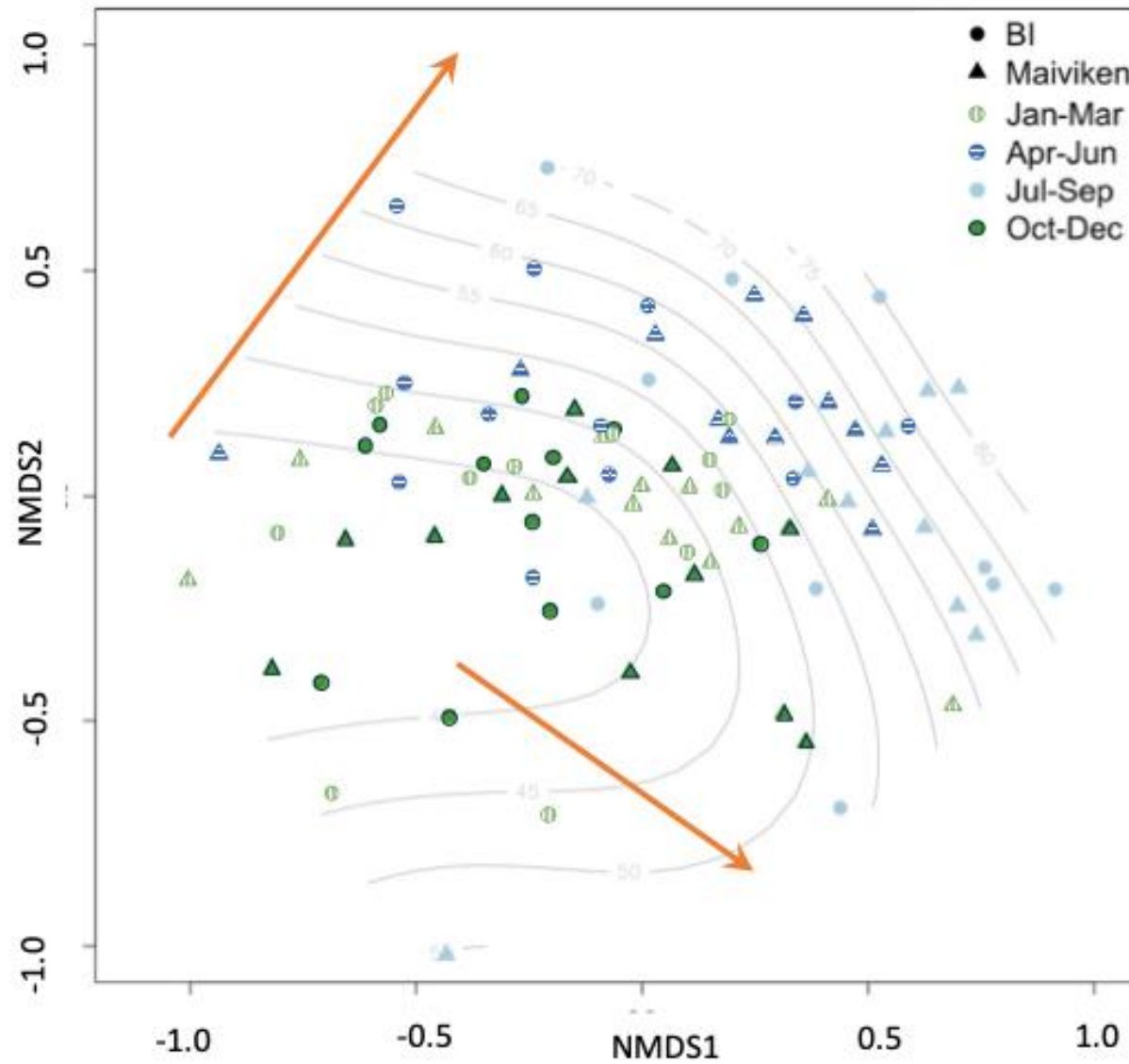
a) Chlorophyll *a*

Online Resource 5. NMDS ordination of dissimilarity in krill community lengths between seasons (Summer = October-March, Winter = April-September) at (BI; green with black outline) and Maiviken (MV; blue) with a) chlorophyll *a* and b) mixed layer depth gradients.



Online Resource 6 nMDS ordination of krill community lengths at BI (circle) and Maiviken (triangle) in quarterly periods from October 2008 (2008-3) until March 2020 (2020-1) (January-March = green with vertical stripes, April-June = blue with horizontal stripes, July-September = light blue, October-December = green with black outline). Mixed layer depth gradients are plotted with arrows showing increased depths. Mixed layer depth explained 39% of the dissimilarities, with third quarter krill being associated with deeper MLD; the second quarter correlated with intermediate MLDs, and the 1st and 4th quarters were shallowest. Shallower MLD depths also isolated several outlier quarterly periods from the main clusters associated with the anomalous period (2017-2020).
