1 **Study Highlights**

- 2 • Only one study previously examined the relationship between FOC and pregnancy  
3 outcomes, but did not measure FOC using a validated questionnaire.
- 4 • There appears to be no association between severe FOC (W-DEQ  $\geq 85$ ) and  
5 birthweight, birthweight centile and gestational age.
- 6 • Findings of the present study could be used when developing educational  
7 interventions to reduce and alleviate FOC.
